Chairman Lanier Keene called the meeting to order.

He asked if anyone was present in opposition to the relocation. No one was in opposition.

He asked if anyone was present in support of the relocation. David Brown, land owner, stated the road has been there forever but they wanted to straighten the road and give more distance between the houses and barns. There is a lot more traffic on the road than there used to be.

Ms. Betty Brown stated the angle of the road makes it hard to see traffic. It would be easier if the road was straightened out. It would also be much safer.

Chairman Lanier Keene stated the county has contacted GDOT and they have approved the relocation of the road and they have said it would be safer if the road was straightened.

Carlton Fisher added that the county would be justified in relocating the road for safety reasons.

There being no further comments, the hearing was adjourned.
