Chairman Lanier Keene called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Tracy Tyndal gave the invocation.

Everyone gave the Pledge of Allegiance.

The **minutes from the September meetings** were approved as presented by a motion from Commissioner Tracy Tyndal. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

No one was present with public comments.

Commissioner comments were as follows:

Commissioner Tracy Tyndal questioned how we looked financially at the end of our fiscal year. County Manager Paula Jones Ball stated we had a very good year. We have not borrowed any of our available tax anticipation note and that if nothing unforeseen happens, we will be able to operate without a loan this year. She added that we are going to make progress on our deficient fund balance. Originally, we thought it would take us five or six years to overcome our financial difficulty but if we can continue to mind our spending and make good decisions, we could possibly be in the black by the end of our 2014 fiscal year.

Commissioner David Brown stated that he had Allen Thompson look at the south porch on the Courthouse. Mr. Thompson is going to look at it again and make his recommendation on the repair.

County Manager comments were as follows:

Manager Ball stated the only thing she was going to address was our status the end of the year and she has already done this. She added that our lead auditor, Jimmy Palmer, is leaving the firm at the end of the year so they want to get started on us before he leaves and at least get his part of the audit done. We should have an audit report ready a little earlier this year.

There being no further business, Commissioner David Brown made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Tracy Tyndal seconded the motion that carried unanimously.
