

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE WILCOX COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HELD ON MAY 5, 2015 AT 6:30 P.M. IN THE COMMISSIONERS CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE WILCOX COUNTY COURTHOUSE.

Chairman David Brown called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Huck Greene gave the invocation.

Everyone gave the Pledge of Allegiance.

The prior month's minutes from the April 7, 2015 Regular Monthly Meeting and the April 15, 2015 Special Call Meeting were approved as presented by a motion from Commissioner Huck Greene. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

There were no guests with public comments.

Department Head Reports were as follows:

Andrew Coccaro, EMS Director, stated the CMS 588B has been approved so no more payments will be going to Crisp Regional Hospital in error. He presented call volume reports. The truck which will be remounted in on the way to Peach State Ambulance so we should have a new truck ready to go on the road within 120 days. M1 is ready to be listed for sale on Govdeals.

A list of equipment has been presented by Road Superintendent Adam Dowdy. The equipment to be declared surplus is as follows:

- (2) Ford 6610 4x4 tractors
- (3) Rhino Single Wing Mowers
- (2) Snapper Riding Mowers
- (1) Grass Hopper ZTR Mower

Commissioner Lanier Keene made a motion to approve the surplus items be placed at auction. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Road Superintendent Adam Dowdy has requested the purchase of a new mower. He has obtained three bids as follows:

Burke Truck and Tractor Company	\$18,000.00
Albany Tractor Company	\$15,928.26
Walker-Rhodes Tractor Company	\$17,480.00

Commissioner Lanier Keene made a motion to accept the low bid from Albany Tractor Company. This mower will be paid by the sale of surplus property. Commissioner Huck Greene seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

There were no items of old business.

Chairman David Brown recognized EMA Director Larry Brown who reported the Hazard Mitigation Plan has been updated.

He then recognized Coroner Janice Brown who stated she is trying to obtain records from the nursing home on the deceased that was cremated to see if there were any funds in his account to help with the expense.

Commissioner Comments were as follows:

Commissioner Lanier Keene presented the need for speed breaks on American Legion, Sibbie and Union Roads. Adam Dowdy, Road Superintendent, will be asked to obtain a price on the breaks.

Chairman David Brown stated he would like to thank Paula and Norris for their work getting everything ready for the Emergency Services Meeting. A request has been received from the City of Pitts requesting the fire truck obtained from the Forestry Surplus program. Paula Jones Ball stated the City of Pitts and the City of Abbeville has requested the truck. Commissioner Keene stated we need to look at the equipment each municipality has. The County Manager was asked to obtain incident reports from Dodge-Wilcox 911 to determine the number of calls in Pitts. Michael Estes, Mayor of Abbeville, stated the incident report numbers should be used.

There being no further business, Commissioner Huck Greene made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion that carried unanimously.
