Sheriff Robert Rodgers stated they had a drowning over the weekend and 44 arrests in July.

EMS Director Charles Futch stated the EMS had 170 calls during July. He presented a back board and trauma bag they obtained from surplus property. Mr. Futch said all the equipment was new and they were also able to get some supplies for the Sheriff's Department.

EMA Director Larry Brown stated they assisted the Sheriff with the drowning and called in Wheeler County EMA for a boat with sonar equipment.
