

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALL MEETING OF THE WILCOX COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HELD ON JUNE 26, 2018 AT 5:00 P.M. IN THE GRAND JURY ROOM OF THE WILCOX COUNTY COURTHOUSE.

Chairman Lanier Keene called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Huck Greene gave the invocation.

Road Superintendent Adam Dowdy presented quotes for a new tractor and ditch bank mower. He was requested to obtain more information and bring it to the July 3<sup>rd</sup> Commission meeting for a decision.

Mr. Dowdy also presented his suggestion for the 2019 LMIG projects. County Manager Paula Ball asked the Commissioners to review the list and be prepared to vote on them at the July 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting.

Sheriff Robert Rodgers requested to purchase two Tahoes from another law enforcement agency. They are 2015 models with one having 77,000 miles for \$20,000 and the other having 96,000 miles for \$18,000. The vehicles are fully equipped so only the striping and radio would have to be added. County Manager Paula Ball stated there were remaining funds from the 2012 splost that can be used for the purchase. She added Recreation has requested a new mower and EMS has requested a heart monitor. The funds for these purchases would be available also. Commissioner Huck Greene made a motion to purchase the vehicles. Commissioner Alfonza Hall seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

The next item on the agenda was the renewal of the county group health coverage. The renewal with Blue Cross Blue Shield was a 37.3% increase. Insurance Agent Noel Williams found comparable coverage with United Healthcare that would be only a 5.1% increase. Commissioner Clay Reid made a motion to accept the proposal from United Healthcare. Commissioner Alfonza Hall seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

The final item on the agenda was a contract from National Fire Service. NFS would provide a plan to lower the ISO rating for the entire County. The cost for the service is \$25,000. Commissioner Clay Reid made a motion to enter into the contract. Commissioner Alfonza Hall seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Commissioners Clay Reid and Lanier Keene thanked Commissioner Alfonza Hall for overseeing the remodeling of the Commissioners Offices.

There being no further business, Commissioner Huck Greene made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Alfonza Hall seconded the motion that carried unanimously.
