Chairman Lanier Keene called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Mel Powell gave the invocation.

Chairman Lanier Keene opened by stating that the meeting would review the Board of Elections and Registrations legislation.

County Attorney Toni Sawyer explained the legislation to the Board of Commissioners and Board of Elections and Registrations regarding the use of compensation time.

Previous Board of Elections and Registrations Chairman Don Roberts and Members voted to allow employees and personnel to receive compensation time.

The Board of Commissioners did not vote when this decision was made. Chairman Lanier Keene and Commissioner Mel Powell met with the Board of Elections and Registrations to discuss compensation time.

Chairman Lanier Keene stated that these were all financial concerns.

The Board of Elections and Registrations personnel claimed that compensation time could not be mandatory.

Board of Commissioners stated that if compensation time was accrued, limitation of 240 hours must be taken.

Board of Elections and Registrations Chairmen Mike Sutton stated that he would oversee overtime for personnel.

Commissioner Clay Reid made a motion to pay overtime during the election year. This would include all overtime between the first day of early voting to the day of election. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

With no further business, Commissioner Clay Reid made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Mel Powell seconded the motion that carried unanimously.
