Chairman Lanier Keene called the meeting to order.

Chairman Lanier Keene gave the invocation.

The first item on the agenda was the sale of the Susan Peavy property located behind the jail. Her asking price was \$5,000, the commissioners had offered \$3,000 at a previous meeting. Now Ms. Peavy has made a counter offer of \$4,000. Commissioner Mel Powell made a motion to table a decision until our October 6, 2020 regular monthly meeting. Commissioner Jowan Johnson seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

The 2021 LMIG projects was the next item of discussion. An updated list of roads was presented to discussion. After much discussion, the item will be placed on the agenda of our next meeting.

The final item of business was a resolution which would add Charles Futch on the original retirement plan. Mr. Futch has worked for Wilcox County previously and was one of the paramedics who went to work for Crisp County when Wilcox County contracted with them to provide our EMS service. Commissioner Mel Powell seconded the motion which carried unanimously.
